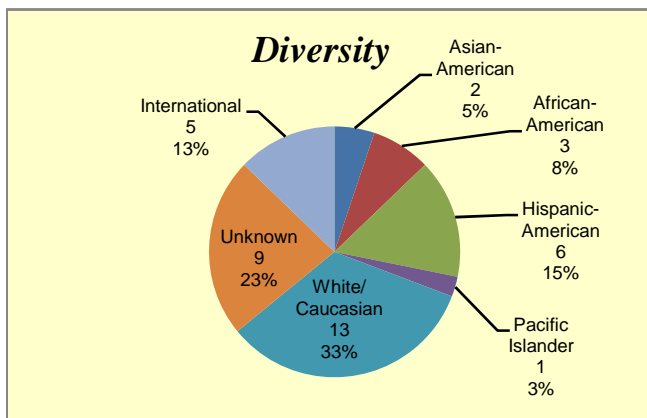

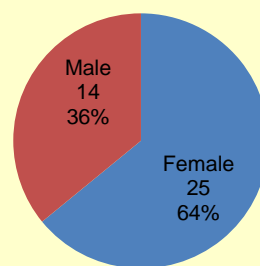

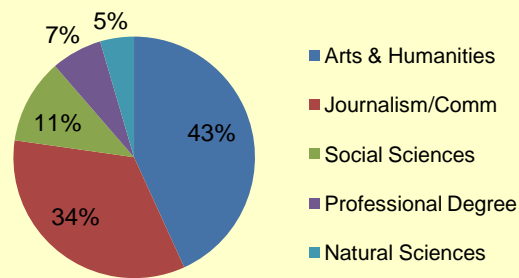
Gender Distribution
